**Domestic Per Diems – CDN or US?**

Please use the following information to determine what currency rate you should receive when operating domestic and transborder pairings:

(Country of origin = place of departure)

Breakfast is always paid at the rate of the country of departure.

If the flight departs prior to 12:00, the lunch is paid at the rate of the country of destination.

If the flight departs after 12:00, the lunch is paid at the rate of the country of origin.

If the flight departs prior to 17:30, the dinner is paid at the rate of the country of destination.

If the flight departs after 17:30, the dinner is paid at the rate of the country of origin.

If the flight departs prior to 22:30, the snack is paid at the rate of the country of destination.

If the flight departs after 22:30, the snack is paid at the rate of the country of origin.

Your pairing must still fall within the parameters of article 7 to be paid any kind of per diem. Stay tuned for an explanation of article 7 in our next bulletin.
