When submitting medical claims to Claim Secure, you must have the items (compression hose, medical braces, orthotics, shoes, etc.) dispensed to you (in hand) prior to submitting the claim for reimbursement. ### **Canada Number One in NAFTA lawsuits**

Canada is the most sued country under the North American Free Trade Agreement and the majority of the disputes involve investors challenging environmental laws, according to a new study from the Centre for Policy Alternatives. Over 70% of the claims since 2005 have been brought against Canada and the number of challenges is rising sharply. Canada has lost six claims paying a total of \$170 million in damages, while Mexico has lost five cases and paid out \$204 million. The U.S. has won 11 cases and has never lost a NAFTA investor-state case.

While governments can be sued under ISDS, there is no similar recourse for states to hold foreign investors accountable for their actions.
