RESERVE RDO PREMIUM

When a reserve member is assigned to work into an RDO (the scheduling program Netline will see this and it will automatically be tagged with "RDO Premium". The problem is that it is not showing on Globe, and the company was not aware of this until it was brought to them recently, as neither Scheduling nor Records access Globe like we do.

There is no fix for having the premium show on Globe at this time, although it may be fixed shortly. If you do not see the premium, call scheduling to confirm that it is there and write down the date, time and name of the person you speak to, so if there are any problems with you pay, we can track it back. To date, we are not aware of anyone having the premium removed when they were entitled to it.
