# **Reconfiguration Complete**

All Air Canada classic B777s have been reconfigured to the "dream" cabin configuration, except for the B777P FINs. With the 1:40 ratio for wide body negotiated in the Collective Agreement, you should see an augmented crew. This means that on B777-300 aircraft (400 pax) you should have a crew of 10 and on the B777-200 (300 pax) you should have a crew of 8. B777P remain unchanged with a crew of 12. Additional crew are added for B14, LOU 18 & LOU22 flights.

If you notice that you do not have the full crew, please advise scheduling ASAP. Should the additional crew not be provided prior to departure, get as much information as you can from scheduling about the short crewing then report it to the local at office@local4092.ca.
