

Your Right to Refuse Unsafe Work

The right to refuse lets a worker step away from work she or he believes is unsafe. The right allows the worker to have the refused work investigated, and fixed if it's dangerous. During the investigation and repair, the right provides that the worker receives pay. And with the right to refuse, a worker is protected from an employer's possible reprisal, since it's illegal for an employer to fire or discipline a worker who refuses work she or he believes is unsafe.

If you find yourself in an unsafe situation:

- Find your **SEP and follow Section 2.20**. This is located at the end of **Section 2**.
- Steps to follow differ when the aircraft is in operation or not and whether you are in Canada at home base or not.
- Make sure you following the right chart accordingly.
