More Money in your Pocket

Spring has sprung and your wallet will be growing along with the spring flowers. Effective April 1, 2017 your hourly salary and domestic / transborder expense allowances will increase by 2%. In addition, we are expecting the 2016 Profit Sharing to be included with your April 17th pay statement. If you are on a leave of absence you will automatically receive the profit sharing upon return to active duty.

Tuck that money away for a rainy day!

May 1, 2017 is the deadline to apply for the deferred salary program (DSP) which allows you to save part of your salary to be used to cover a 6 month to 1 year leave of absence. Check your Passport info!

We have had a rise in the number of flight attendants being removed from flights dues to errors in the passport info in Globe.
